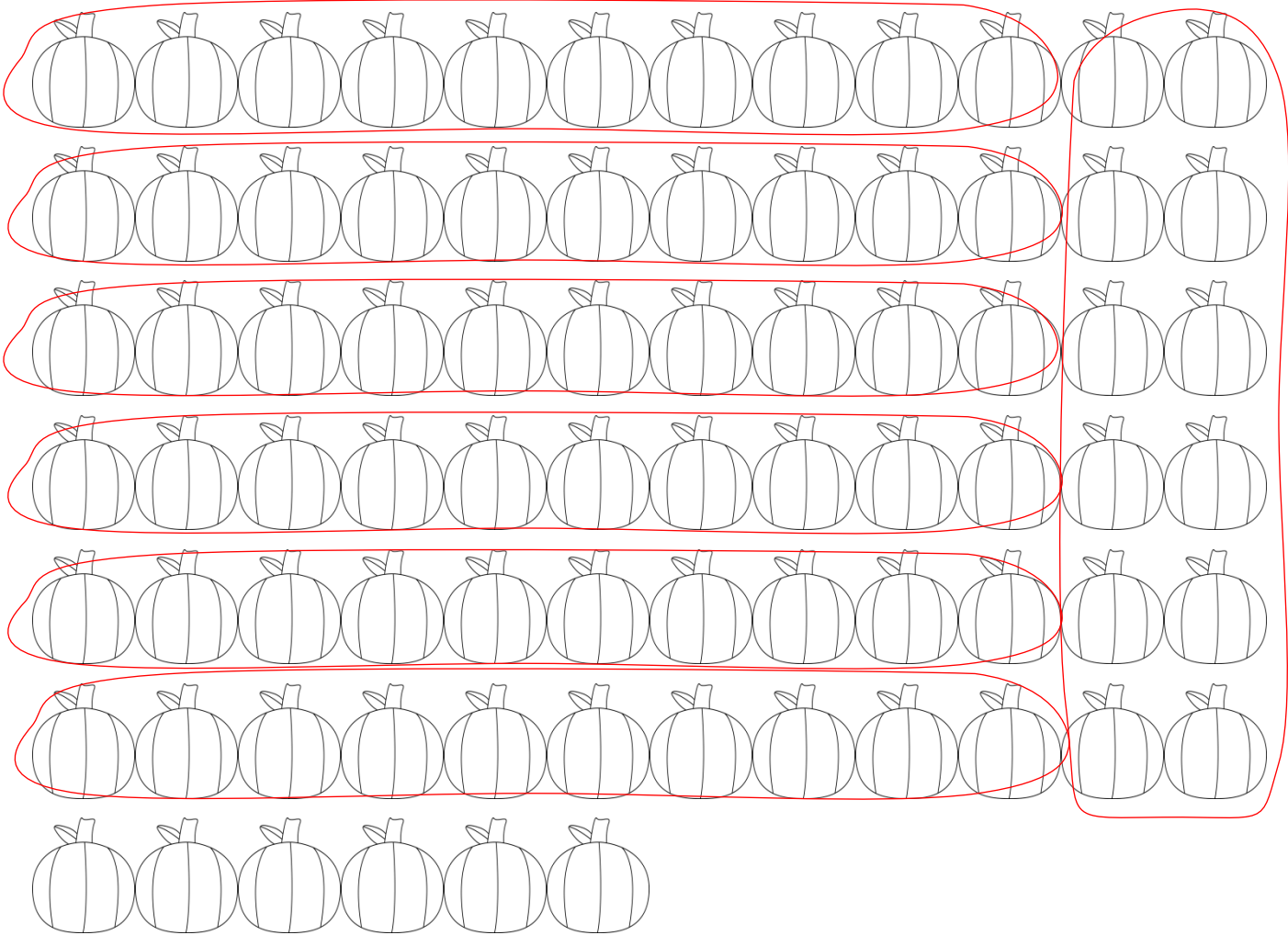
Using The Color Counting Charts

Color counting charts can be used in class to support students in their ability to count.

These charts can be used whole group to practice counting in a variety of ways. It can also support students with noticing different ways items can be grouped (i.e. horizontally, vertically, by 2's, 5's, 10's, etc). Through these counting opportunities students can begin to identify a variety of strategic ways to determine the amount shown in each picture.

These charts can also be printed and laminated as an opportunity for independent student practice. Students can look for ways to make groupings that make counting easier and more efficient in a way that makes sense to them. Student counting page can be used as a way to record and challenge students' thinking.
